MAJOR CENTRES

T20 format

Played on Turf wickets

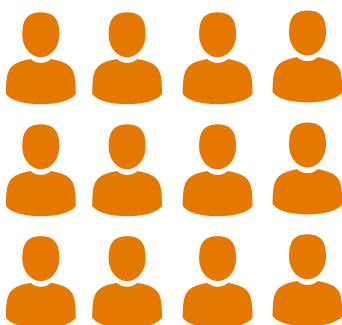
Suitable for players with club cricket experience

Players can not 'play down' in either Community Division

Cricket spikes are highly encouraged to be worn

Players in this division are eligible to play for the Northern Territory in the National Indigenous Cricket Championships

12 PLAYER TEAMS



All players must identify as Indigenous



MEN'S COMMUNITY DIVISION

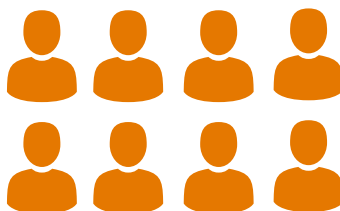
Super 8's format (14 over games)

All games played on synthetic wickets

Suitable for players new to the game

One player per team is able to act as a 'fill in' player for one Major Centres team if required and remain eligible to play for their Community team.

8 - 10 PLAYER TEAMS



Max of 2 non-indigenous players per team - exemption forms must be completed if player hasn't played previously



WOMEN'S COMMUNITY DIVISION

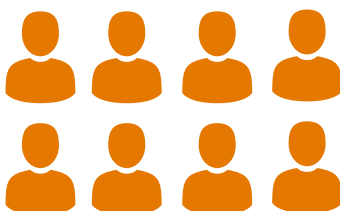
Super 8's format (14 over games)

All games played on synthetic

Suitable for players new to the game

Players may compete in the Major Centres division and remain eligible to play for their community team

8 - 10 PLAYER TEAMS



While there is no eligibility criteria for the women's division, teams are encouraged to actively attract and involve Indigenous women in their sides.
